## Memorandum of Agreement

This document lists the shared goals of the Federal Aviation Administration's Columbia, SC Flight Standards District Office (CAE-FSDO), the South Carolina Aeronautics Commission (SCAC), and the South Carolina Aviation Association (SCAA) for the development and maintenance of programs and procedures that enhance aviation in the State of South Carolina. This agreement is not a legally binding agreement; rather it is a process for communication of goals and mutual plans toward aviation safety education and the promotion of aviation within the State.


The CAE-FSDO, SCAC, and SCAA have a longstanding relationship in which each organization has committed available assets to improve aviation. Because of their mutual contributions to aviation safety, pilots, mechanics, and airports in the State of South Carolina have benefited through increased aeronautical knowledge, improved safety, and general awareness of the aviation industry.

Each entity has a desire and commitment to respond to the needs of aviation safety within their respective areas of responsibility and expertise, and each share the goal of "Safer Skies" in South Carolina. The intent of this agreement is to endorse and increase cooperative efforts between the CAE-FSDO, the SCAC, and the SCAA. These cooperative efforts can include, but are not limited to, the following:


- Elevating South Carolina's aviation community to a higher level of awareness and safety
- Information sharing and dissemination as part of the South Carolina Aviation Safety Council
- Sharing of airport safety and navigation aid hazard information
- Working together in accident/incident investigations
- Preparation and distribution of written safety information and electronic communications
- Preparation and dissemination of information through seminars and other public programs
- Promotion and linking of partner websites
- Safety information sharing through the FAAST Team programs
- Marketing of safety and compliance materials
- Data base development and sharing
- Employee training and workshops
- Promotion of flight instructor and maintenance recurrent training courses/safety seminars
- Other mutually agreed upon areas for the common good of aviation in South Carolina.






