# FY2024 AIP Program

- **Federal Register Notice (FRN) is expected soon.**
- **ATL-ADO is proceeding with **May 15, 2024**, as the deadline for airport sponsors to submit final applications, based on bids, for grants that will be funded with FY24 entitlement funds only.**
- **ADO PM will contact Sponsors who have projects being considered for discretionary to coordinate when bids/applications should be received.**



# FY25 Call for Projects

**Airport's annual Airport Improvement Program (AIP) funding request and preapplication package were due December 1, 2023.**

- **FY 2025-2029 5-Year Capital Improvement Plan (CIP)**
- **FY 2025 AIP Funding Request Preapplication Package**



# Grant/Project Documents

## Common documents to be submitted to the ADO

- Executed Consultant Contracts
- Plans & Specs
- Certified Bid Tab
- Executed Construction Contracts
- Contract Award Recommendation Letter
- Notice to Proceed Letters
- Change Orders

**Note: Please provide documents as they are generated. Don't wait for ADO request.**





# Consultant Contracts

- **All Sponsors acknowledge that they are responsible for consultant selection/contracts meeting Federal requirements per Sponsor Certification for Consultant Selection.**
- **Per Certification, Sponsors agree to:**
  - **Conduct consultant re-selection every 5 years (max)**
  - **Prohibit cost-plus-percentage in contracts**
  - **Identify costs associated with ineligible work separately from costs associated with eligible work**
- **Planning Projects (Studies, EA, EIS) require their own RFQ, separate from engineering projects.**
- **The AIP Handbook (Order 5100.38D, Change 1) is a good source of information regarding AIP eligibility and Federal requirements. Information is easily searchable in the pdf.**
